#### **OSU Extension**

- Keith Smith's retirement from his role is effective June 30
- Greg Davis has been named as our Interim Associate Dean and Extension Director, effective June 30
- Search process for the next OSU Extension Director well underway
- We are in active recruiting phase right now please provide any intriguing candidates to members of the search committee
- Anticipate interview process for late summer or early fall

#### OARDC, Research, & the Wooster Campus

- Steve Slack has announced his retirement from his role as Associate VP, Associate Dean for Research, & Director of OARDC, effective December 31
- This transition lends itself to a reorganization in CFAES leadership
- Effective January 1, 2016, Dave Benfield will assume role as Associate Vice President of Agricultural Administration & Director of the Wooster Campus; reporting line to VP/Dean as member of admin cabinet
- Initiate search this summer for Associate Dean for Research & Graduate Education

## The Wooster Campus = OARDC + ATI

- Dave Benfield will lead Wooster campus operations, including responsibility for our distributed research and teaching infrastructure
  - OARDC and ATI will continue to be at the core of the college's Wooster presence; OSU Extension will maintain significant presence through administration and faculty appointments
  - Focus on operating facilities in a systems manner to ensure that our mission areas have access to the unique resources that our Wooster campus provides
  - Continued connection with the Agricultural Experiment Station system
- Rhonda Billman's role will expand to Assistant Director, Wooster Campus Operations, effective July 1, 2015
  - Will report to Dave Benfield

#### CFAES Research and Graduate Education

- The new Associate Dean will have responsibility for leading the college's research function and will also take leadership of our graduate education portfolio
  - This individual will have college-wide responsibility for the research enterprise, including research reporting, sponsored projects, technology commercialization, advocacy for research infrastructure, and seed grant programs
  - Grad education will continue to be the responsibility of academic units, but this
    college office will provide coordination for a variety of common elements, such
    as best practices in recruiting; funding mechanisms; graduate student
    mentoring; graduate student professional development; and providing an
    interface with the Graduate School

#### Academic Leadership

- Graham Cochran has agreed to serve as interim chair of Agricultural Communication, Education, and Leadership, effective July 1
- Faculty/Staff review processes are in progress for reappointment of Scott Shearer (Food, Agricultural, and Biological Engineering) and Terry Niblack (Plant Pathology)
- Faculty/Staff review process is in progress for extension of interim appointment of Jim Kinder (Ohio State ATI)
- Reappointment review for Associate Dean Linda Martin is in progress (Academic Programs)

#### Support Unit Leadership

- Information Technology Services
  - Effective July 1, Matt Devore will assume the role of College Chief Information Officer
  - Communications staff with IP video and certain online teaching/ learning tools will join the ITS staff effective July 1
- Planning & Facilities
  - Effective July 1, Brian Hanna will assume role of College Facilities Planner, report to Ron Hendrick

#### Support Unit Leadership

- Building & Fleet Maintenance, Wooster Campus
  - Joe Messenger will assume leadership for both building and fleet maintenance for the Wooster campus; report to Dave Benfield
- Business & Finance
  - Eric Bode, CFAES Senior Fiscal Officer has been working over the past year with our fiscal team to develop comprehensive planning, budgeting, and reporting approaches for the entire college
  - Effective July 1, Brian McClain and Terry Snoddy will report to Eric, while maintaining working connections with extension and research leadership; Ohio State ATI will also join this comprehensive budget approach

#### Farm Operations

- Ken Scaife's leadership role will expand on July 1, when he assumes leadership of all CFAES farm operations
  - At least 6 months to coalesce the business/fiscal pieces
  - Expect to coordinate CY16 growing season across the college
  - Begin the process of determining balance of livestock herd/ flock sizes
  - Develop a governance model that ensures we are providing assets necessary to support teaching, outreach, and research
  - Report line to Dave Benfield

## **Equity and Inclusion**

- Kathy Lechman will assume the role of Director of Equity and Inclusion for the college; report line to Ron Hendrick
  - Develop a strategic roadmap for future programming
  - Establish a Dean's Advisory Committee on Diversity and Inclusion
  - Serve as a resource for innovative programming across the college that will have positive impact on all units and mission areas
  - Ensure that we remain in compliance with our federal civil rights expectations

#### Distance Education and On-line Learning

- Deana Namuth-Covert will assume a leadership role for CFAES efforts related to distance education and on-line learning
  - Deana will work with ODEE, CFAES Academic Programs, ITS, Communications, and OSU Extension technology specialists to develop a comprehensive strategic plan
  - Curricular decisions continue to rest with academic units, but CFAES can and should provide tools and a broader strategic framework
  - Initial reporting line to Ron Hendrick

#### Communications

- Ryan Schmiesing will assume new responsibilities as CFAES Chief Administrative Officer on July 1, focused on strategic CFAES initiatives and high level administrative processes; report to VP/ Dean
- Over the next 6 months, we will transition to new leadership for the Communications team, focused on a search for a Director of Marketing and Communications
  - Report line still to be determined, but member of senior leadership team
  - Ryan Schmiesing to provide interim leadership

## Hospitality/Event Management

- Over the next year, we will evaluate our CFAES event and hospitality portfolio, with the intended outcome of an integrated and strategic approach to using our many assets – venues and people
  - Our outward-facing venues and the events we host are key components of our stakeholder relationship management
  - CFAES units plan and host a wide range of conferences and workshops, which involve substantial staff and faculty time
  - How do we best maintain a reputation for excellence?

#### Farm Science Review

- Farm Science Review is the nation's leading university-sponsored, agriculture-focused outreach event
- Our VP luncheon has become a victim of its own success.
- At FSR15, we will host two events
  - Celebration of Ohio Agriculture
  - Elected officials, association & non-profit leaders, statewide govt representatives, private-sector leadership, university leadership
  - Celebration of CFAES
  - Alumni, faculty, and staff working at FSR, donors, friends of the college, Hall of Fame inductees

## **CFAES Facility Conversations**

  - Kottman Hall renovation
  - Master Plan documents are available on the website for review
- Keep in mind that Master Plan and our conversations are just that conversations
  - Much fact-finding required to make informed decisions
  - We will be continue to walk through facilities, talk about options and change, and commission drawings and estimates
