Students in need of assistance or emotional support should reach out to the Office of Student Life's <u>Counseling and Consultation Service</u>, or a CFAES <u>embedded counselor</u>. Students can also access the support and resources provided by the <u>Student Wellness Center</u>, the <u>Student Advocacy Center</u>, the <u>Center for Belonging and Social Change</u> and the <u>Office of International Affairs</u>. Faculty and staff in need of assistance can contact Ohio State's <u>Employee Assistance Program</u>.

During Open Enrollment, Ohio State is sharing information about a new benefit that will be available in 2023 – <u>Lifestyle Spending Accounts (LSA)</u>. An LSA allows you to personalize your benefits and be reimbursed for eligible expenses that support overall health and well-being. You can use these funds for a broad variety of purchases and activities related to emotional, physical, financial and social well-being. A quarterly contribution of \$125 will be allocated to employees on January 1, April 1, July 1 and October 1 to be used during that quarter. Other new benefits include surrogacy assistance and caregiving back-up support. Eligibility is defined as full-time and part-time (50% FTE) in regular or term positions.
