Executive Vice President and Provost Melissa L. Gilliam has shared Ohio State's new Academic Plan, which will serve as a framework for transforming academic life at Ohio State. The plan is built upon Ohio State's passionate and lasting commitment to academic excellence and is the result of visioning, benchmarking, and stakeholder engagement over the past year. While the plan is the result of thoughtful work, it is also a starting point and an invitation to the university community to imagine what academic excellence can look like at Ohio State and how all can take an active role in creating our future.

Ohio State is conducting a campus engagement census to elicit feedback and input from faculty and staff that will help advance the university's mission and purpose. Results from the census will provide baseline data on what Ohio State, university leaders and managers can do to support individual talent and cultivate an environment that inspires excellent outcomes. The census will open to employees on Monday, Nov. 7, and close on Friday, Dec. 2. Additional communications will be forthcoming.
