

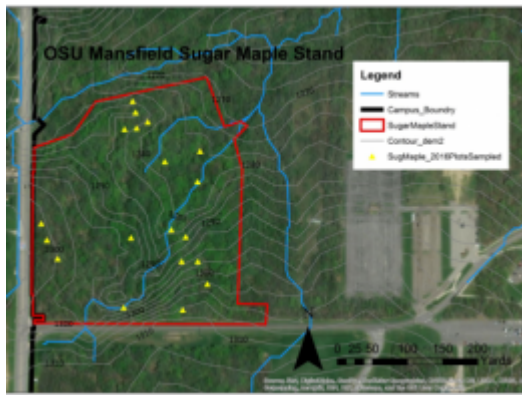
CFAES Teaching Today's Learners: Professional Learning & Development Series
