CFAES Biometric Screening Days 3/25 and 6/2

Each year the Your Plan for Health (YP4H) program offers <u>incentives</u> when you annually complete a **verified Biometric Screening** and a **Personal Health & Well-being Assessment (PHA).** Medical plan enrolled employees can <u>reduce</u> the cost of their <u>medical contributions</u> by \$25 per month or by \$40 per month if they and their enrolled spouse completes the PHA and biometric screening.




