Workday Timeline Update

The Enterprise Project schedule has been updated to reflect a six-month Workday timeline extension. Workday HR and Payroll will go live on **January 3**, **2021**. Workday Finance and Supply Chain will go live on **January 7**, **2021**. The university's Workday Student timeline remains unchanged, with implementation planned to begin in summer 2023. The college is challenging all staff, faculty, postdocs, and graduate students to view and comment on 3 research posters. The CFAES <u>Virtual Poster Competition website</u> will be online until **May 15**, at which point posters will be removed and comments will be sent to poster entrants. These comments are highly valued and help our researchers improve their skills.

Not sure what to comment?

- Was something unclear from their poster? Ask a clarifying question.
- Did you like the poster layout or use of images? Make comments about the design or content of their posters.
- Were you totally confused? We ask that posters are designed for an educated, but general audience. It is useful to let researchers know if their language wasn't clear.
- Did you really like the topic? Let them know!
- How does this research relate to you or your department? It is helpful for researchers to hear other applications or collaborators they may not have thought of.
- Include comments related to any included narrations. Did they speak clearly? Was their presentation easy to follow?
