New Social Media Policy

Effective April 15, 2019 The Ohio State University adopted The Institutional Social Media Accounts for Marketing and Communications policy along with accompanying Protocols and Standards published to assist with implementation. You can download the policy and accompanying documents at go.osu.edu/socialmediapolicy.

The policy applies to all faculty, staff, student-employees, and other individuals who create and/or maintain institutional social media accounts for university marketing or communications purposes.

One of the requirements in the policy is an annual audit of all institutional social media accounts. **Account managers must complete the audit survey by July 15, 2019.** The survey will not be available until July 1, the link will be forwarded when it opens. Social media account managers should plan to complete the audit survey during that two-week window. The audit questions can be found on page 6 of the <u>Social Media Policy Playbook</u>.
