The Ohio State University Board of Trustees recently announced the [search process for the university's next president](#) — a search that will include opportunities for the Ohio State community to participate. I look forward to serving on the University Advisory Subcommittee. The first meeting is on March 21.

Yesterday, we held the ribbon-cutting ceremony for Starlab and welcomed industry partners as well as leaders from Voyager Space and Nanoracks to the Columbus Campus. CFAES will serve as the lead partner for the first-ever science park completely devoted to space research. The terrestrial analog facility will grant the college unprecedented access to space-related agricultural research, the ability to synergize with partners in industry and across the land-grant system, and the opportunity to engage in additional outreach with K-12 and 4-H students.
