## Staff Advisory Council (SAC) is advocating for you

Members are appointed by unit or department heads, 25 members plus 2 at-large (at-large positions are decided through an application process), throughout the college for a three-year term. Officers are elected by council members annually. The Council meets six times a year in different locations throughout Ohio. The purpose of the Council is to:

- Provide a formal vehicle for staff participation in the betterment of the College by shaping an environment that promotes mutual respect, builds teams, and creates a compelling place to work and learn
- Increase the efficiency and scope of communication within the College and University by:
- Act in an advisory role to the Vice President of Agricultural Administration and Dean, College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences by serving as the staff voice/liaison to the Vice President/Dean
- · Relay communication from the Vice President/Dean to staff
- Facilitate staff-to-staff communication
- Broaden university-wide communication through its relationship with the University Staff Advisory Committee
- Support the CFAES core goal, "To be the standard of excellence for colleges of food, agricultural, and environmental sciences."

## Task Forces

#### **On-Boarding**

Develops a consistent orientation plan to connect new employees with needed resources.

## **Staff Recognition**

#### **Staff Appreciation**

#### **Communications**

Communications also compiles and distributes the "Years of Service" display and certificates. Currently, Communications reviews all material created by SAC for branding compliance and consistency.

#### **Professional Development and CFAES Road Trip**
